We are not just another rehab center - we are a community that understands the unique challenges that women face on their journey to recovery. For over three decades, we have been providing gender-specific supportive services to women, including those who are pregnant, parenting, or have young children. We firmly believe that being a parent should never be a barrier to receiving the help you need. We are here to ensure that every woman has access to the care and support she deserves.

At STEP2, we recognize that addiction is not just an individual struggle, but a family one. That's why we provide a comprehensive continuum of care that focuses on healing both women and their children. We understand that many of our clients are single mothers, battling addiction while trying to provide for their families with limited resources and support. Our program is designed to empower women to reclaim their lives and build a brighter future. With our year-long program, women receive residential inpatient services, outpatient services, transitional housing, and a range of wraparound services. From case management and medical care referrals to childcare assistance and parenting education, we are committed to addressing every aspect of a woman's journey to sobriety.

But our support doesn't end there. We also provide transportation assistance, domestic violence advocacy and education, and on-site mental health assessment, therapy, and medication assistance. 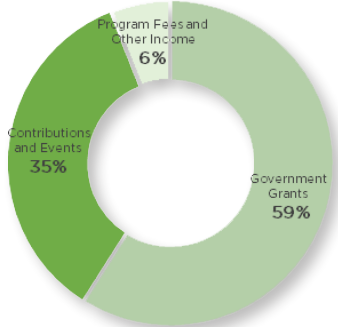

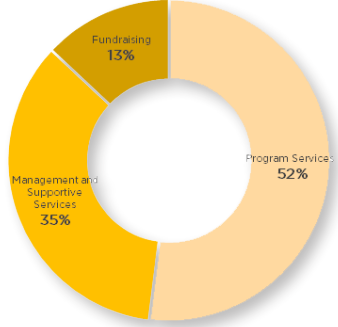
